January 17, 2023

The regular meeting of the Hereford Township Board of Supervisors was held in person at the Municipal Building and via Zoom. Payment of Bills and Approval of the Treasurer’s Report

Mr. Membrino made a motion and Mr. Masemore seconded to pay the bills and approve the Treasurer’s report. All were in favor. Motion carried.

Fire Companies

- A. **Hereford Fire Company**- Chief Borowski reported fourteen calls received and responded to for the month. Budget requests were reviewed. Mr. Marks followed up again with Ryan McKenzie’s office regarding Penn DOT removing the wrong dead tree in the right of way on Conrad Road. Penn DOT stated they will return and remove the correct tree. Mr. Marks also reported on a cardiac arrest incident and commended the ambulance crew and fire company crew for their work.
- B. **Seisholtzville Fire Company**- Chief Strickland was unable to attend. The Fire Company responded to 19 calls. They continue to do fundraisers and apply for small grants.
- C. **Hereford Fire Police** – Mr. Albitz reported the time for the Hereford Elementary School dance in is too early and the fire police won’t be able to make it.
